From the Pastor's Pen ...

One of the most powerful spiritual gifts that we are able to give another person is to listen to them. Any form of listening has the ability to be holy. I have listened to people's dreams. Also, I have learned to lean in while listening. This means listen instead of giving advice or figuring out a problem. When being taught pastoral care, we are taught to listen without judgment and to listen when it becomes painful. Listening allows us to be present for people.

On the Road to Emmaus in Luke 24, we hear of Jesus meeting two disciples on the roadside. When he meets the disciples, his first response isn't to tell them everything about the Messiah. He takes time to listen to the disciples account of the events. Jesus listens to the devastation of losing their teacher. Further, he hears them. At any moment Jesus could have jumped into the conversation telling them that they were wrong and saying I am here. Christ didn't prove himself. It was about listening to their problems and difficulties. After listening fully, Christ tells the disciples of their misunderstanding of his life and work by opening their minds and eyes to the scriptures especially what they foretold about him. It was a process of hearing them first. Then he could address their concerns.

Listening is a key aspect of faith. One of my practices is to pray and listen for God's will in my life then pray for the ability to carry it out. It usually turns into me hearing a call to be present loving the person in front of me. Recently it has been about learning to love myself how God loves me meaning take care of all aspects of my health and to be present with myself and others.

As I listen in more than just our congregation, I hear deep fears underneath the voices of people. One of the biggest fears that I hear is what is the future of the church. Things have changed a lot since I was a child and even more drastically in the past decade not just here yet in other places too. Our communities do not look the same. Christ is the same person who guided the early disciples. We are called to listen to him still today. He listens and explains the gospel to us and our current context. Turning here for guidance changes our lives and the world. We are called to be disciples in a weary world.

Recently, I have heard the need to move to a different form of communion for early service by returning to intinction. It helps the flow of Altar Guild in preparing communion. It helps ensure the ministry is completed. We will start in June. Even though it is in a different form, this is one place where we see the Risen Christ just like the in the Road to Emmaus story. It is in the breaking of the bread. We will still be breaking the bread weekly. It will just be a different form. It still offers us a taste of grace.

When we gather around a meal together, Christ nourishes us giving us grace needed in a weary world. Let us listen for places of grace and be nourished by it.
